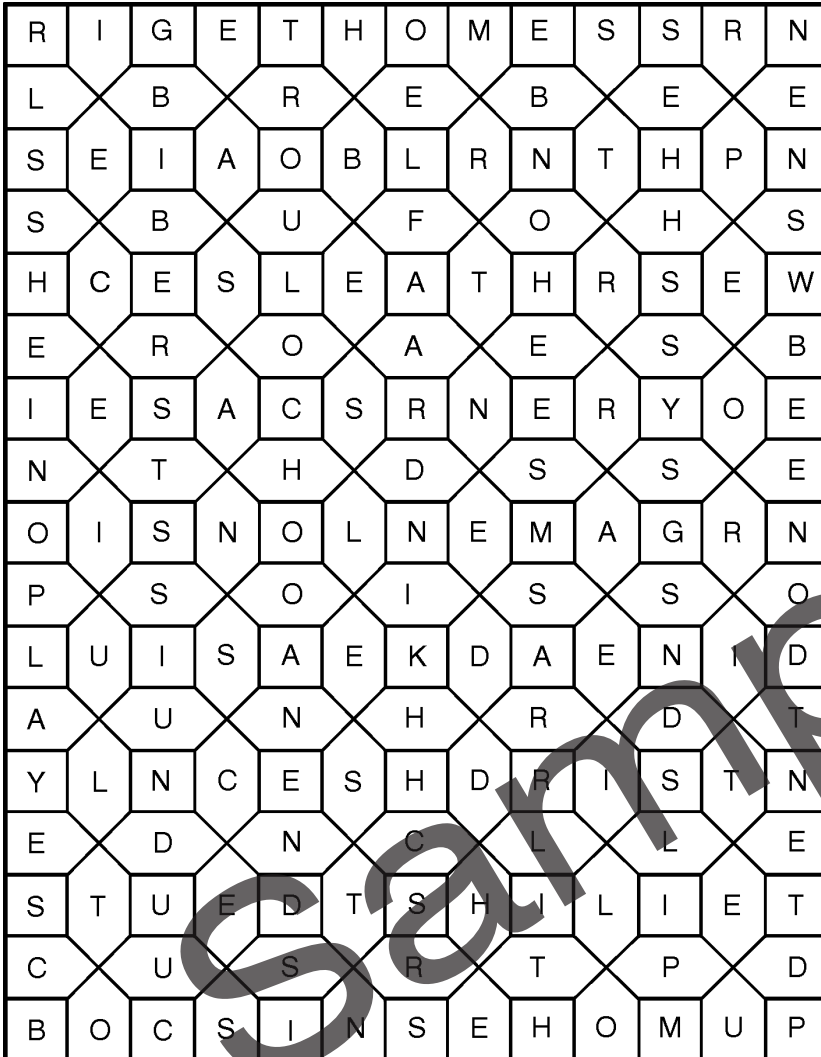

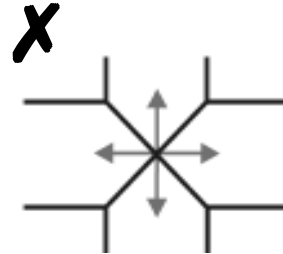

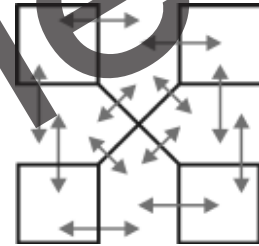
Tile Search

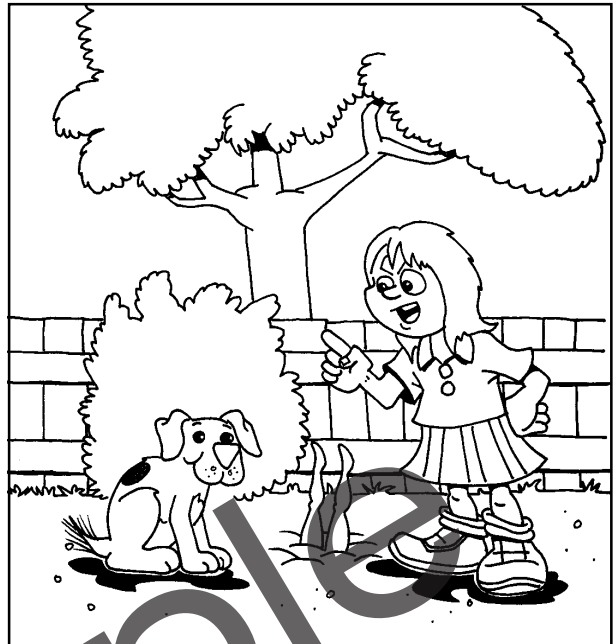
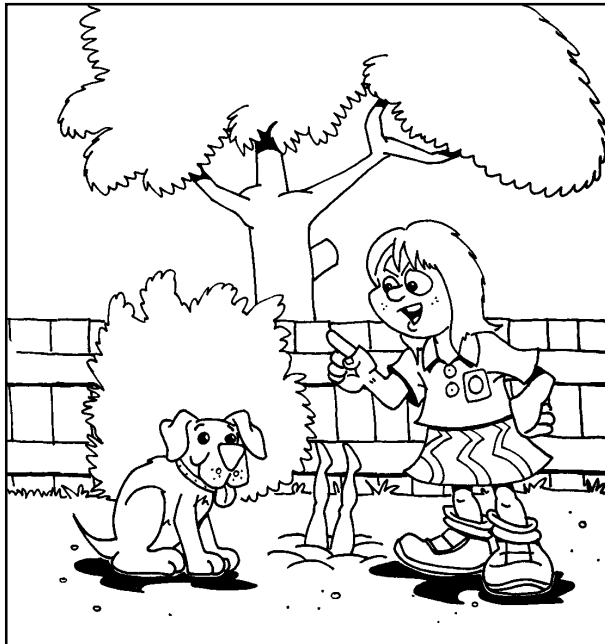
