4. Cut out each strip and staple them together in order to create a flipbook.



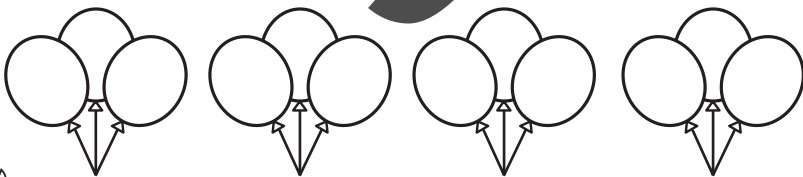

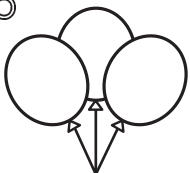
